KREBS LECTURE/RECITAL MARCH 21

Margaret and Margaret Dickinson's Bach Haus is the site of the next dinner and program, which will include a talk by Melvin on Johann Krebs and several performances featuring their 15 stop Gottfried Reck pipe organ. Melvin will play Krebs' *Prelude and Fugue In C*, Margaret will do a concerto by Krebs and a contemporary of his for organ and duo corno di caccia (Michael Tunnell and Bruce Heim). Additional instruments will be trumpet, flute (Nancy Blandford) and oboe (Katherine Albertson). Organists will also include Phil Brisson and Dennis O'Donoghue.

The **6:30** meal will be a Bach's supper catered by Stevens and Stevens and will consist of a sandwich, salad, chips, a cookie and soft drink. The price will be \$9 or less. Reservations must be called in to Phil Brisson (**582-2971 x120**) by **Friday, March 18**.
