He won one of the top prizes which entitles him to a full-tuition scholarship for the Doctorate of Musical Arts Degree. He will begin the degree in September, while continuing to teach part-time at U of L and working part-time as Director of Music at Christ Church Cathedral (and playing the Saturday service at St. Mark's).
