JOHN BROCK RECITAL NOVEMBER 20

The University of Louisville and the Louisville AGO Chapter will co-host a recital in **Comstock Hall at U of L on Friday, November 20**. Emeritus Professor of Music at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville, **John Brock** has developed a wide reputation as an outstanding organ teacher and performer. A graduate of the University of Alabama as an organ student of Warren Hutton, he is the author of an organ method, *Introduction to Organ Playing in 17th and 18th Century Style*. His recordings include two volumes of *A Tennessee Organ Tour* and the complete organ works of Hugo Distler.

The **8:00 program** will include music by Mendelssohn, J.S. and C.P.E. Bach, Near and Rogg. A reception in the lobby, sponsored by Webber and Borne Organ Builders, will follow the recital.
